NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Entries Close 6:00 PM Thursday, 22 November 2012 at the Test Secretary's residence, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered, or substituted.

Entries limited to Eight (8). Two entries will be set aside for workers at previous tests. Entries accompanied by valid TTCVA Test Worker Reward Certificates totaling at least eight (8) points are eligible for the test worker draw for this TD test.

Bitches in season will be allowed to participate. The test secretary must be notified prior to the drawing for tracks on the day of the test.

Entry Fee: \$125.00. Make checks payable to TTCVA. Mail signed AKC entry form with fee to **Tom Siegmund, 1904 Foxwood Dr. Chesapeake VA 23323**

Passes – The club provides passes to the Yorktown Battlefield for each exhibitor. *Additional passes for guests can be purchased from the Park Visitor Center for \$10.00.*

Drawing of Entries – as required by AKC Tracking Regulations will be at **6:00 PM Thursday, 22 November 2012** at **1904 Foxwood Dr. Chesapeake VA 23323**.

The random drawing is open to all interested parties to determine which dogs will participate in the test. Entries from eligible test workers will be drawn for the two set-aside tracks. After these two set-aside tracks are filled, any remaining test worker entries will be added to the non-worker entries for the draw of the remaining tracks. When the advertised eight entries have been drawn, all remaining entries will be drawn for a position on the alternate list. Titled dogs will be drawn after all untitled dogs. The Test Secretary will attempt to notify all entrants of the draw results immediately after the draw by phone and / or email.

Refunds – In the event that an accepted entry withdraws after the closing date to allow an alternate to replace said entry, the entry fee will be refunded within 7 days following the test. In the event an accepted entry withdraws after the closing date and there is no alternate to replace said entry, the entry fee will NOT be refunded.

Awards – A framed map of the track will be awarded to each team that successfully completes their track. Maps will be mailed after the test.

Single copies of the latest editions of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" and "Obedience Regulations" may be obtained WITHOUT CHARGE from any Superintendent at any show where they are superintending or from THE AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB, 5580 Centerivew Drive, Raleigh, NC 27606-3390.

AGREEMENT

I(we), acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" and, if this entry is for an Obedience Trial, the "Obedience Regulations," have been made available to me(us), and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. I(we) waive any and all claims, causes of action, I(we) might otherwise have against the AKC and any AKC approved judge, judging at this show, under AKC Rules, Regulations and Guidelines. I(we) agree that the club holding this show or obedience trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the show or obedience trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I(we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the show or obedience trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I(we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I(we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I(we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself(ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this show or obedience trial, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rules refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
